SUMMARY: The patient is a 39-year-old gentleman who was admitted for pain in the right upper quadrant of the abdomen. The patient was found to have acute cholecystitis. He underwent laparoscopic cholecystectomy and cholangiogram.

This patient stated that in the recovery room he started having pain in the right upper quadrant of the abdomen. This pain was significant, and after having an uncomfortable night, the next morning a HIDA scan was done, which showed a questionable leak. We got a CT scan done, and the CT scan did not show any significant collection. I asked Dr. Seip to see him. An ERCP was done, and a small leak was found. A stent was placed in.

Today this patient is feeling better. His liver function tests are slightly elevated, which is expected. His pain has improved, and he is afebrile. At the time of discharge his white blood cell count is 12,000, hemoglobin 13, hematocrit 38, direct bilirubin 1.7, total bilirubin 2.4, SGOT 226, SGPT 229, alkaline phosphatase 207.

This patient insists that he wants to go home. I offered him a stay of one extra day, but the patient is adamant that he would like to go home today, so he is being discharged home on Ultracet, Demerol, Ativan and Tequin.

DISCHARGE DIAGNOSES:

1. Acute cholecystitis.
2. Postoperative bile leak.

ADDENDUM: After the initial discharge summary was dictated, this patient started having pain. His discharge was canceled. Dr. Seip saw this patient again. A repeat CT scan was done. The patient showed pancreatitis. I also placed a consult to Dr. Klee Bethel for his pain management. A repeat HIDA scan was done. There was no evidence of leakage present. This patient was given a PICC line, started on a nasogastric tube and TPN. Today he is feeling better. His abdomen is soft and less tender. He is just taking Bextra for his pain. His staples have been removed and replaced with a Steri-Strip. The patient will mainly be followed by Dr. Seip for the removal of his stent.

DISCHARGE DIAGNOSES:

1. Acute cholecystitis
2. Biliary leak
3. Post-endoscopic retrograde cholangiopancreatography pancreatitis
4. Paralytic ileus secondary to #3
